***A message from George F. Heinrich, M.D. and Sandra Brown-Sherman, Esq.***

On behalf of the Board of Directors, we are pleased to announce that **New Jersey Health** Foundation is launching its next cycle of Research Grants Program funding and will be accepting applications from September 10, 2018 through November 2, 2018. We have committed at least \$1 million in this current cycle.

Through this program, in its 28<sup>th</sup> year, **New Jersey Health** Foundation (NJHF) has awarded more than \$58 million in grants to advance promising research.

Full-time faculty members, staff and other personnel at these organizations are eligible to apply for grants of up to \$35,000 each to fund early health related projects that demonstrate exciting potential and/or projects that help researchers obtain data that may qualify them for larger grants from other organizations (e.g. NIH, NSF):

- Kessler Foundation
- New Jersey Institute of Technology
- Princeton University
- Rowan University
- Rutgers University
- Stevens Institute of Technology

Policies & Procedures and a sample Letter of Agreement are attached and can be found on the **New Jersey Health** Foundation web site at [www.njhf.org](http://www.njhf.org) along with a link to the application portal. Prior to submission to NJHF, all applicants must follow their organization's standard approval protocols and procedures. Grant applications can then be submitted directly to **New Jersey Health** Foundation electronically and will be reviewed by the **New Jersey Health** Foundation Research Grants Committee.

*Submission to NJHF does not guarantee grant funding.*

Awardees will initially receive 80% of their grant award and will receive the final 20% upon submission and acceptance by **New Jersey Health** Foundation of their final narrative and financial reports at the completion of the project.
